

## Kerala Pharmacy Graduates Association Student Project Scheme

## **GUIDELINES**

- 1. The scheme provides financial assistance to students enrolled in professional courses in Pharmacy (graduate, post-graduate) to carry out projects in pharmacy.
- 2. The project should not be as a part of curriculum/submitted or intended to be submitted to any universities or statutory bodies. Instead, they should exhibit novelty and demonstrate the potential to deliver beneficial outcomes to the community.
- 3. Both the Student and Supervisor/Guide (PI) should be MEMBERS of KPGA at the time of application.
- 4. Any student enrolled in pharmacy (graduate, post-graduate-B. Pharm, M.Pharm, Pharm.D) courses in Colleges in Kerala can apply. The number of students per project shall not exceed five.
- 5. Scanned copies of duly filled applications (Page No.2) should be sent to the email <a href="mailto:kpgastudentfund@gmail.com">kpgastudentfund@gmail.com</a> in the prescribed format from the Principal Investigator / Head of the Institution. Hardcopies of the application will not be accepted.
- 6. The maximum financial assistance released to a selected project will be Rs. 5,000/-. Last date of application is 15<sup>th</sup> June , 2023.
- 7. The selection of the project for the financial assistance is done through a peer review process, and evaluation by an expert committee appointed for the same. The decision of KPGA in the selection of projects shall be final.
